


Renovation plasters





Crown murals brighten up Darwen

tesa insight on importance of preparation

In a new survey of professional painters and decorators by adhesive manufacturer, tesa has revealed an insight into the importance of preparation work, product purchasing decisions and important industry information sources.

Surveying 450 painters and decorators across the country, the results highlighted preparation is a key part of a project, with 56 per cent always using tape to prepare for a paint job, while 3 per cent only use when creating design features.

Although the basics remain the same, many aspects of the painting and decorating sector have changed in the last decade. Whether that is due to new trends in colour, the rise of innovative paint technologies or the growing importance of issues like indoor air quality, the market looks different to the way it did in the early 2010's. Nowadays, to get the most from the profession, it is essential to have a firm grasp on these developments and what's more, it is important to have an awareness of where things will go next.

One area that is garnering increasing attention is plastic waste. Construction activities in particular tend to generate a lot of waste material, which often can't be recycled. As such, the industry ranks amongst the least sustainable around. In fact, the sector consumes 23% of all plastic produced in the UK, and generates an

estimated 50,000 tonnes of plastic packaging waste every year.

Shockingly, within this mix are more than 100 million plastic cartridges, which are being sent to landfill each year – including those empty filler cartridges decorators throw away on a daily basis.

In light of this, manufacturers are responding with more modern, sustainable solutions. Geocel Painters Mate, for example, is now part of the re-launched ecoSEAL system, which means that the product is now available in more environmentally friendly foils, which are used in conjunction with a re-usable sleeve.

With the ecoSEAL system there's no need to buy an expensive barrel gun. It's easy to use - simply cut the foil, insert into the sleeve, attach the nozzle and fit into any standard gun. Each sleeve can be used an average of 75 times and is also recyclable – and when empty, the foils are eight times smaller than traditional cartridges, meaning less waste is sent to landfill.

Additionally, the system is more lightweight than foil barrel guns, which reduces fatigue in user's arms and enables nimbler usage. Similarly, as the ecoSEAL sleeve is clear, users can also always see exactly how much product is left. cost-effective solution than ever before. In recent years, there has been escalating costs associated with disposing of on-site waste. In particular, waste that needs to be sent to landfill - such as single-use plastic filler cartridges - are now more expensive to dispose of than before. The driving force behind this increase has been landfill tax, which has trebled since 2008 to a current

cost of £91.35 per tonne of landfill waste.

Decorators who adopt more sustainable solutions won't only see a positive impact on their bottom line, in fact, making the switch can help them to boost their environmental credentials with customers. For painting and decorating firms, choosing more sustainable products is an easy way to highlight this point. As we enter a new decade, it's clear

that consumers have a better understanding of the environmental impact of their purchases. The rise of the 'ethical customer' is a phenomenon felt across industries and will only continue to rise. In fact, almost half of people under the age of 24 say they actively avoid products or services which have a negative environmental impact. As these people grow older and buy homes for themselves, it is likely that this decisionmaking process will extend to home repairs. As such, decorators who shun sustainable solutions could reasonably expect to be challenged, in the years to come.

Shifting to more sustainable technologies doesn't have to mean compromising on performance, or paying more. Instead, it can represent a way to improve working practices and attract new customers who are more conscious about their impact on the world around them.

While professional decorators know the value of a quality brush and roller, the tools selected for any job can also improve your productivity and efficiency on site. When working on a project, choosing the most suitable brush for a specific job really can make a difference.

Purdy has advocated the use of a suite of brushes and rollers, each made for a certain application with part of its design, such as the shape and filaments, selected for a specific purpose. All-encompassing brushes are not designed or shaped for a specific job, which may ultimately result in more time spent on site correcting mistakes, and a subpar product will need to be replaced more often once the bristles have been damaged by paint or stains.

An angled brush, for example, is perfect for cutting in corners and detailed trim areas. It is designed for tight spaces and allows for a greater control in difficult places. Conversely, a flat wall brush such as Purdy's Monarch Elite is a thick brush designed with large

surface areas and productivity in mind.

Available in five sizes, the bristles have been carefully designed to pick up and lay off more paint than a regular brush, helping get the job done faster, without compromising the quality of the finish.

In addition, purchasing brushes that have specific filament blends for different types of paints and coatings, will not only ensure the best finish for the job but will also improve the longevity of the brushes as after-care is much easier.

For example, some bristles types are only used for stains, varnishes and oils - as if used

in water-based paint, decorators will find that the brush absorbs the water in the finish - causing the bristles to splay out in the brush. In contrast, the Purdy Sprig, for example, is a thinner synthetic filament brush made for water-based paint, so the bristles won't 'swell' and will retain its shape, allowing you to apply the paint with less drag, leaving you with a flawless finish.

In the same way there are specific brushes for different applications, the same goes for rollers. There are a variety of sleeves available, which all achieve different finishes and can distribute paint more densely than brushes.

Generally, the length of material, also known as the nap, will determine the outcome. The smoother the

surface is, the shorter the nap on the roller should be. Short naps are recommended for internal walls as these provide the smoothest finish. A longer nap is typically designed to better resist wear and tear are designed to leave a great finish on rough surfaces such as artex or textured wallpaper. Longer naps also help to get into the small crevices on the wall – this is especially important if painting over exposed brick.







Painting floors

James Burton of Bradite looks at what is involved when undertaking the painting of both domestic and industrial flooring.



Whether you're painting flooring in a domestic setting, a warehouse, a workshop, a school or hospital kitchen, an underground car park or something a little more challenging like an aircraft hangar or helipad, site preparation and product selection are the keys to success.

It is important to remember that not all floor paints are the same. Generic products include alkyds, polyeurethanes, epoxies, single pack, twin pack, water-based, solvent-free, moisture cure, chlorinated rubber and more. They may be described as domestic, industrial, garage, hard wearing, tough and flexible.

For domestic use, you may require a quick drying, low odour product that is easy to apply such as a single pack, cross linking water-based paint. For a light industrial situation, the coating should be hard wearing, grease resistant and able to cope with light to medium traffic. A single pack polyurethane, or a water-based cross-linking product may work well.

For heavier traffic areas, such as a workshop floor where oil and grease are present, you could try a moisture cure, chlorinated rubber or twin pack epoxy. To achieve quick-drying and recoat times, try a water-based cross linking moisture cure or chlorinated rubber.

In a working environment, such as an area for food preparation, you should use an odour and solvent-free product. Consider water-based cross linking or twin pack water-based epoxies.

There are certain circumstances where the coating must resist specific chemicals. In these cases, identify the chemicals and check the coating suitability directly with the product manufacturer.

In settings where regular deep cleaning is required such as a brewery or kennels, consider chlorinated rubber or twin-pack epoxies.

Substrates

Whether it's concrete, steel, timber, or something else, the substrate upon which

the coating is to be applied is critical. When choosing a coating, consider whether the substrate is new or aged, inside or outside, or previously covered with a different coating.

New concrete should be left for a minimum of 30 days before painting to allow time for it to completely dry out. This can be checked by laying a rubber mat on the floor and leaving it overnight. When removed, if the floor is discoloured or condensation is still visible, then moisture is still present, and the floor should be left until fully cured.

New concrete should also be checked for laitance, a milky deposit on the surface usually caused by excess water in the mix. If painted, it could act as a crust and detach from the base causing premature failure of any coating. This can be removed by blasting or acid etching.

Power floated, shiny or unpainted nonporous concrete flooring should be thoroughly blast cleaned, ground, acid etched or primed using an adhesion promoting floor primer before applying floor paint. The correct application of screeds is important so check with the manufacturer to ensure the screed is suitable for overcoating.

The correct preparation of steel substrate

depends on whether it is ferrous or nonferrous. Remove corrosion to brighten the steel, treating any stubborn spots or marks with rust converter before applying a primer. If previously painted, all coatings must be well adhered.

Turning to timber, softwood knots should be wiped and sealed using knotting compound or aluminium primer. Resinous hardwoods should be wiped with methylated spirits prior to priming with aluminium wood primer. The moisture content of the timber should be below 15%. Damp wood should never be painted as this will give rise to blistering, flaking and cracking. Damaged, rotten and darkened timber should be repaired prior to product application.

When covering previous and existing coatings, if possible, identify the existing product and check its compatibility with any new coatings. Existing coatings should be well adhered to. Any flaking, damaged or loose material should be removed back to a firm edge. Substrates should be clean, free of oil, grease and dust and completely dry before application of any product.

Preparation

Clean with high pressure wash and sweep to remove all loose debris. Degrease using an industrial degreaser and rinse. Lightly abrade the surface, blast or acid etch, vacuum to remove all dust and ensure the substrate is completely dry prior to application of the new coating. With power floated floors, once the surface is cleaned, they can be prepared by vacuum blast, grinding or diamond grinding, acid etching or the use of adhesion primers.

Application

With product selection and preparation now complete, we can move on to application. The method of application will depend on the product selected and the manufacturer's instructions. As with any application, it is important to understand the product's recoat, drying, and curing times. This information may be found on data sheets or provided by the product manufacturer.

Remember, most manufacturers will offer on-site and specification help. The old adage holds good: failure to prepare is preparing to fail!

Oiling the wheels of fortune

Picture this: a professional decorator just finishing another great job. They are proud of the work they have done, but they look around and realise that the furniture and other wooden surfaces around the house are looking tired and in need of some attention. These surfaces are spoiling the finished effect. The customer might be time-poor or lacking in DIY skills, and at the point of quoting for the project, if only they had offered to take care of the woodwork at the same time, they could have created a far more finished look, whilst adding some welcome extra profit to the bottom line. Here Richard Bradley of Liberon looks at one of the oldest forms of wood finishing: the application of oils, which gives a natural, hardwearing finish with an unmistakable sheen and silky smoothness that customers will appreciate.



The great thing about the right oil is that it is highly resistant to moisture and heat. Easy to apply, it greatly enhances the colour of the timber, intensifies the grain pattern, and feeds timber safely, from well-worn rocking chairs to turned woodwork. Some specially blended oils even provide UV protection, making them ideal for helping to prevent wood from fading.

Where an oil is required to protect hard and soft woods both indoors and outdoors, it is recommended that a low viscosity option is selected, which allows deep penetration of the wood to feed, protect and enhance it. Select a blend of pure tung oil and natural oils with an added UV filter for protection against sunlight. Ideally, the oil chosen should have a resin content that affords protection against water, heat and alcohol plus added driers for quick drying.

Liberon's Superior Danish Oil protects against daylight and is alcohol, heat and food acid resistant, making it safe for use on kitchen surfaces. It is also ideal for doors and skirting boards. Outdoors it may be used on wooden garden furniture.

To prepare interior woodwork prior to applying this oil, ensure the surface is bare. Remove any wax finishes and any varnish finishes. Clean, dry and ensure the surface is dust free. To prepare exterior woodwork ensure the surface is clean, dry and free from decaying timber. Surface greying or mould should also be removed as this may cause blackening of the timber. If there is discolouration then treating with Liberon Wood Bleacher can help.

On interior jobs apply the oil with a brush or lint-free cotton cloth and allow to penetrate for five to ten minutes before wiping off the excess with a clean lint-free cloth. Allow to dry for a minimum of five hours, and apply more coats as required. It is recommended that a minimum of three coats are applied. For best results gently rub with Liberon's Ultra Fine Steel Wool (Grade 0000) between coats. Instead of steel wool use a fine sandpaper (400 grit or finer) on exterior Oak. In damp areas, such as kitchens and bathrooms, more coats will be required to ensure adequate protection. On exterior jobs the same application process applies. Four coats are recommended for minimum



protection. This oil can darken some light grained timbers, therefore it is a good idea to test it on an unseen area first.

Where an oil is required to provide a hardwearing finish, and the surface in question comes into contact with food it is recommended that a premium, pure and natural oil be selected with no additives. Pure Tung Oil is the ideal solution. Look for a very high water resistance to ensure it is suitable for exterior use on items such as garden tables or barbeque surrounds. Liberon's Pure Tung Oil is also ideal for external oak furniture on which it helps to prevent black spot problems.

To prepare wood surfaces prior to applying this oil, firstly ensure they are bare. This means removing any wax finishes with Liberon's Wax and Polish Remover and any varnish finishes with Liberon's Fine Wood Stripper. Clean, dry and ensure the surface is dust-free.

To apply this oil, use a brush or lint-free cotton cloth. For ease of application dilute the first one or two coats with up to 50% white spirit. Allow the oil to penetrate for 20 to 30 minutes then wipe off the excess oil using a clean lint-free cloth. Allow to dry for 24 hours between coats. Apply further coats in the same way, reducing the amount of white spirit used with subsequent coats. Apply the last one or two coats undiluted. After the final coat has been applied, and the excess removed, leave for 24 hours and wipe over again to aid drying and remove

any oil that may have surfaced. It is recommended that a minimum of four coats are applied, and more coats will be required for porous or external surfaces. Again, for best results gently rub with Liberon's Ultra Fine Steel Wool (Grade 0000) between coats. Instead of steel wool use a fine sandpaper (400 grit or finer) on exterior Oak. Leave for a few days before use to allow this oil to dry fully. Again, testing the oil on an unseen surface is recommended.

When looking for an oil that can be used on interior wood and turned woodwork that will really nourish and enhance the colour of the wood, seek out a blended option containing hardwearing oils and resins for a lasting and water-resistant finish. Liberon's Finishing Oil has a resin content that enables protection not only against water but heat and alcohol too. By applying extra coats of this oil, resin build-up is facilitated, which means that a variety of finishes can be achieved, including matt, satin or gloss. Seek out a low viscosity oil to ensure deep penetration, that makes it ideal for all types of bare wood. If working in kitchens and bathrooms it is recommended to choose a water-resistant formula.

Preparing the wood before using this oil is the same process as that mentioned above. To use it, the container must be shaken well before beginning, then a coat can be applied using a brush or lint-free cotton cloth. The oil should be allowed to penetrate for up to ten minutes, then all the excess should be wiped off with a clean lint-free

cloth, before the surface dries enough to become sticky. Allow to dry for a minimum of five hours, and apply more coats as required. A minimum of three coats is recommended. The more coats applied the higher the sheen and the more durable the finish will be. As for the other two oils mentioned above, for best results gently rub with Liberon Ultra Fine Steel Wool (Grade 0000) between coats.

Why the feel of your brush is so important

In research conducted recently by Hamilton, 'the feel' of the brush ranked number 4 in the top ten most important factors when choosing a brush. But what is 'the feel' and why is it so important?

Put simply, 'the feel' refers to the way the brush feels in your hand. Think about it - this tool is in your hand for eight hours a day it's like an extension of your arm! If it feels uncomfortable in anyway, your mind will not be on the job, focus will be lost and its likely that the finished result will suffer. Not great in an industry where your reputation matters

Even more worryingly, aches and pains can develop leading to more serious conditions like repetitive strain injury (RSI).

So, both financially and health-wise, ensuring that your brush has the feel is incredibly important.

Can you feel it?

Sarah Coussens of Hamilton said, 'Talking to professional painters and decorators for our research highlighted the ways in which the feel of the brush can impact them and their iobs.

'Comfort was a big issue with many stating that without comfort, there was little control - and reduced control had a negative effect on their confidence in the finish. Many compared it to holding a pen, in that the brush has to be balanced in the hand, easy to use and allow a flow to develop whilst they are painting.

'In fact, one respondent said, 'The feel is crucial...your brush is an extension of you... and displays your talent...you couldn't be a good footballer with a burst ball!' This statement clearly demonstrates how passionately you professional decorators feel about the results that they deliver to their customers and how they look at every aspect of their tools to ensure they can achieve the best outcome on their jobs.'



Avoiding injury

The repetitive movements that are part of the painting process can present a hazard, especially when your tools don't 'fit' you properly. Repetitive strain injury (RSI) is a real issue for some.

Several areas of the upper body can be affected but pain in the hands and wrists is most likely for professional decorators. Symptoms that start off as a mild ache can quickly develop into more severe pain and swelling requiring medication, physiotherapy and extended periods of rest, all of which may impact your business.



Trousers for females



ProDec has designed decorator's trousers for females

Time and time again we heard the same issues; ProDec had been involved in some lively debates over the years about the lack of choice for females when it came to painters' workwear. When Elise Colledge began working on the ProDec clothing range - a female product manager with a female manager in turn - it seemed an opportunity missed that there wasn't a dedicated women's option.

Recently there has been a surge in the uptake of apprenticeships in painting and decorating by females, some colleges reporting an increase of 30%. We knew that higher waisted trousers worked best - no one wants to be uncomfortable when they're working - with a ladies' fit around the hips and waist."

"We really felt the time was right to produce something for women to be able to afford," Elise expanded. "Options were available but some of the costs were out of reach when these women were just starting out. We designed something specifically for women and worked with a number of women decorators to test, refine and test again over a period of time to ensure they were right."

ProDec Advance Women's Painter's Trousers are available in selected stores and online. They

feature the same stylish two-tone design as the men's version, with a stain resistant coating to keep them looking great, high waisted with elastic for added comfort and triple stitched seams for strength. Available in sizes 8-18 with a standard leg length, each pair includes a Wipe-Mate, an innovative, washable patch to wipe hands which attaches to buttons at the side.
