



# Tradesmen lift the lid on cowboy customers

The crimes of cowboy builders are well publicised, but AXA's latest study\* finds the rogue traders may well be out-numbered by rogue customers. Customers having a cavalier attitude towards tradesmen's safety and wellbeing is common, as are attempts to belittle their expertise, but the worst behaviour would be considered serious workplace harassment in any other context.

Eight in ten tradesmen told the survey they regularly encounter customers who attempt to knock down the agreed fee or avoid paying them on various pretexts – pushing back payment deadlines or disputing the fee only once work is complete.

Other types of behaviour are self-defeating, as clients unwittingly hinder work or prevent the tradesman from carrying it out properly. The most common ways customers undermine a building project, as voted by tradespeople, are:

- Insisting on cheap or unsuitable materials
- 2. Not providing clear job specs
- 3. Ignoring their advice
- 4. Asking them to do tasks they aren't qualified for
- 5. Hanging around while they try to work

Another bugbear is having to work around animals that are not properly under control: a third of tradespeople have been attacked by a home-owner's beloved pet: ("My mate told me the dog was coming, but I thought he was joking and carried on painting the window frame. It sunk its teeth in my leg: I got up the ladder and was trapped on the roof".)

Meanwhile, twenty six per cent of tradespeople say they have had a customer flirt or attempt to seduce them in a way that made them feel uncomfortable. Far from finding these situations comic, tradespeople often feel demeaned or threatened by this behaviour.

### **Cash payments**

A recent survey by home service marketplace, Plentific.com, has revealed that almost half (46%) of UK adults admit to having paid a tradesman cash in hand for work, in order to get a cheaper deal.

This new data comes following the recent Taylor Review, by Matthew Taylor, in which a reduction of cash in hand payments in the UK was suggested. Mr Taylor stated that work paid for using cash could be worth up to £6bn a year, and quite often goes untaxed. While a complete ban on cash payments was not put forward, the review did suggest that a cashless society, largely due to the increasing popularity of digital payment platforms, could one day be the norm.

The statistics show that adults aged 55 and over are more likely to pay a tradesman cash in hand (56%), compared to young adults (18 to 34-year-olds), of which just 33% admitted they had paid using cash to get a cheaper deal. While this suggests that the older generation may be more thrifty when it comes to hiring a tradesman, it could also be a reflection of the changing times, with cash payments becoming far less frequent in today's economy.

Based on location, Liverpool came top of the table for the number of adults who say they have paid a tradesman cash in hand for work (54%). According to the data, a quarter of Londoners (25%) said they have paid a tradesmen in cash in the past year. This compares to 22% of adults in Plymouth and Southampton, and 21% of adults in Cardiff.

Other common questions asked by customers included whether the tradesperson could provide references (5%), the source of their materials (5%), if they are a family firm (4%) and if they used apprentices (3%).


The research was conducted by 'HaMuch', a new comparison service designed to help the trades become clearer on price and, as a result, help tradespeople secure work.

### **Ideas for Satinwood**

1

When thinking about this new series of articles, I decided to keep things as simple as possible. I fully understand that not everyone has had the benefit of training in the subject or access to specialist tools and that there is a need to help the less experienced and give hints and ideas but then it is a case of practise, practise, practise.

2

Satinwood is a very beautiful golden coloured wood found in central and southern India and is of a very similar structure to Mahogany. It is commonly used for furniture, interior joinery, veneering and inlay work.

**Panel 1.** For a simple one-pass straight grain effect, mix an acrylic glaze with some raw sienna/yellow ochre and a touch of Vandyke brown. Remember, you can always adjust the colours accordingly. Brush your glaze onto the panel and let it set for 10 minutes. Then, simply pull a flogger through the glaze. Leave this for another 5 minutes, then soften sideways with a badger softener. Don't oversoften. When you are satisfied, soften up and down the panel.

Panel 2. This panel is similar to the mottling/moires found in certain types of Satinwood. Using the same acrylic as on panel 1, first flog the panel and allow to dry. When dry, glaze the panel. Then using an old credit card in a walking fashion, create the mottling. When satisfied, soften sideways with the badger softener. Then gently soften upwards to finish.

### specialist**finishes**

Panel 3. On this panel we have a simple heartgrain 3 effect with mottled sidegrain. The heartgrain is created by using a damp square synthetic sponge. The sidegrain was then mottled as in panel 2 but slightly softer. Finally soften the heartgrain first followed by the sidegrain. Panel 4. This is a simple version of feathered satinwood. Based on the same principles of graining, glaze the panel but making the centre slightly darker. Then, with a damp natural sponge, wipe put the feather shape. Soften and let the panel set for 10 minutes. The take a damp overgrainer and put in the heartgrain. Soften gently as you go, let the panel dry, overglaze and mottle. Finish with an acrylic satin varnish. This is my last feature and I would like to thank the Professional Painter & Decorator magazine for the wonderful opportunity to write these articles, and Benjamin Moore for its sponsorship. # Choosin paint brushes

hen looking for new paint brushes, it can be tempting to opt for the cheapest available rather than looking for more options on the market, and this can result in poor finish and the need to repurchase sooner. Looking for higher quality brushes which are suited to the project and coating, and correctly maintaining them, will be more cost effective over time than cheap, generic brushes.

### **Buying the right product**

ensures that jobs are completed quickly and to a high standard, and will also prevent brushes from becoming damaged. Using a high quality brush will also mean the filaments will last longer, saving you money on the job in the long term.

### Maintenance and care

Even with high quality brushes, it is essential that they are regularly maintained to ensure that they continue to perform well and last even longer.

There are several simple steps you can take to ensure you are making the most of your brushes and keeping them in good shape. Firstly, it is vital that the brushes are kept clean after every use. This should be with the use of a brush comb, such as the Purdy Brush Comb, which removes stubborn paint and ensures filaments

remain straight when drying. This should be used after every use by washing any paint out with warm water or white spirit.

Users should also be careful not to soak brushes in water or white spirit for a long period of time, as this can cause the filament to bend and deform.

Another key maintenance tip is to keep the packaging 'keeper' that the brush comes in to ensure the filaments maintain their shape, and to hang brushes from the handle rather than their ends.

The life of a paintbrush will also vary due to factors such as the type of projects that

With falls from height being the third highest cause of fatal injuries in the workplace, WernerCo is offering Ladder Association accredited training for professionals to improve knowledge and safety. In 2010, changes to legislation on Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) shook up the painting and decorating industry. It was long before then, however, that Johnstone's Trade identified a need for new water-based paint technology.

Our research highlighted that the market was experiencing issues with changes to solvent-based undercoat and gloss solutions, particularly around yellowing and drying times. Experienced professional painters and decorators were also reluctant to try water-based trim products. We understood that we needed to address the issue for the industry and provide new water-based products with new technology.

### The first generation

In 2006, the first generation of Johnstone's Trade Aqua Gloss was launched to the market. While this new paint solution came with the environmental benefits of being water-based, it was met with mixed reviews and initial apprehension from

professional painters and decorators to try something new.

We know that painting and decorating is a craft and, understandably, professionals didn't want to stake their reputation on a new product.

So, we worked with a large number of professionals who had used our Aqua Gloss, as well as loyal solvent-based professional painters and decorators to gather feedback. The research process comprised reviews of a number of factors including technological performance, application, colour and availability. From this our new product development journey began and the decision was made to develop our water-based technology and produce an improved formulation.

We took our time to ensure that we could offer our customers the best solution, so it wasn't until 2012 that we launched the second generation of the Johnstone's Trade Aqua System.

### New and improved

The new and improved formulation was a water-based technology that had the benefits that a solvent-based paint has to offer. We recognised that a full waterbased solution wasn't going to be immediately popular with users of solventbased paint, as we knew that they didn't like the application properties or the flow and feel of water-based products that were already available to market.

So, we created a hybrid product that applies like a solvent-based paint with self-levelling properties and improved flow, while having the added characteristics and environmental benefits of a water-based paint.






# and UK Standards changing

There is now a new standard for ladders which is outlined in an 8-page guide by the Ladder Association.

"The most extensive review and update since standards for ladders were first established." That is how the Ladder Association, the not-for-profit industry body dedicated to ladder safety, is describing the revision of BS EN 131 - the single British and European product standard covering all types of portable ladders. The Ladder Association has published an 8-page guide explaining the changes and, importantly, the implications for specifiers, users and health and safety professionals.

A long-standing member of the European standards committee for ladders, CEN TC93, the Association has made a major contribution to the development of the new standard. The changes include improved stability and enhanced test requirements designed to improve strength, rigidity and durability.

Following the changes, there are now two classes of ladder: 'non-professional' for domestic users only and 'professional' for use in the workplace. Both have the same minimum capacity of 150kg.



Comments the Ladder Association's technical manager and chair of its Technical Committee, Don Aers: "These are positive changes that improve ladder design and therefore ladder safety. However, with change can come uncertainty, which is why we have produced the guide."

"It makes clear that ladder standards do not apply retrospectively so there is no immediate requirement to change existing ladders. Business users should simply give consideration now to updating their purchasing policies as soon as reasonably practical to reflect the latest standard when new or replacement ladders are required."

"During this transitional period users will

also be able to purchase ladders meeting the old - BS 2037 and BS 1129 - ladder standards, but the opportunity to do so will diminish over time as supplies are exhausted."

"The revised standards are now published and manufacturers are currently in the process of changing over to the new designs."

Whilst ladders may not always be the first choice when working at height, they are often a sensible and practical option for low-risk and short duration tasks, and there are many situations where a ladder is the only practical option.







# Spontaneous combustion, be safe

Decorators should be aware of the possibility of spontaneous combustion when using products such as linseed oil, especially in the warmer weather. Although the risk has lessened since the introduction of VOC regulation, good practices should still be observed.

Solvent based oils, paints and other coatings that are applied by cloth can, given the right environment, be potentially hazardous due to the excess product remaining on the material. Products and coatings that carry this risk will indicate so on the packaging, therefore it is always advised to read this thoroughly before starting the job.

#### Where does it occur?

When decorating, the main risks arise when rags or cloths, used to apply coatings, are left in a pile. The chemicals in the coating react with the oxygen in the air (oxidation) creating heat that cannot escape from the pile and therefore the risk of combustion is increased.

As you would expect, the summer months when the air is warmer and drier presents a greater possibility of spontaneous combustion plus the use of the riskier types of products is more popular at that time of year.

Mineral oils such as white spirit, mineral turpentine or lubricating oil are not so prone to self heating. Drying oils however, such as linseed, rapeseed, cottonseed, peanut, corn and fish oil pose a possible risk.

#### Reducing the risk

It is simple to prevent spontaneous combustion since oxygen is required for it to occur.

Cloths that have been used to apply hazardous coatings can be immersed in water or spread out in a safe place to dry to reduce the risk.

When transporting product soaked cloths between jobs or sites they should be sealed in metal containers as this will prevent the oxidation reaching a critical point.

n 2016 Peugeot's Expert Van went through a complete overhaul. Now with a new platform, better styling and some safety features to complete the equipment list. The Expert in the UK is a much admired van with the middleweight van users but there is some competition.

Peugeot's Expert uses the same underpinnings as Citroen's C4 Picasso and Peugeot's 308 passenger vehicles but of course with much strengthened suspension to enable the van to cope with loads one expects in a commercial environment.

Driving the Expert Van is like driving a car giving the driver a more relaxing day and a less fatiguing experience. This adds greatly to road safety with an alert driver at the wheel. Unlike vans of yore modern vans have power steering and if ordered automatic gears,

however most plumb for a manual for its simplicity.

The Expert comes in three body lengths and two wheelbases lengths. The standard van measures 4,950mm whilst the Expert Long comes in at 5,300mm and the shorter Expert is 4,600mm long. The three body sizes can also be bought as a conventional van or minibus able to carry nine passengers in three rows of seats.


